

# ThriveAP Upskilling Program Increases NP & PA Assessment Scores

## METHODOLOGY

ThriveAP has recently announced the launch of its latest primary care program. This program is specifically tailored to enhance the skills of healthcare professionals who are seeking to expand their practice offerings to comprehensive primary care offices or to align with value-based care models. To date, more than 400 seasoned NPs and PAs across the United States have started the program which consists of 9 hours of asynchronous material focusing on quality chronic disease management and the patient experience. Participants were given a baseline examination followed by a post-program examination to assess the knowledge gained.

## THE RESULTS

Results of the pre/post examination scores are summarized in the figure below. 135 NPs and PAs have successfully completed the program, showcasing an average of a 56% lift in pre/post scores. The average Baseline Assessment Score of those that have completed the program ranged from 47% to 65%, whereas the Post Program Assessment Score ranged from 78% to 94%.
